All the Business Incoming must have a B1 English Level. • For Traineeships in Dentistry, Physiotherapy, Nutrition and Medicine, the exchange student must hold a B2 Spanish Level. • Additionally, we offer some courses in English. • All our Masters are delivered through Spanish. Incoming students applying to a Masters at UCV are required to have a B2 Spanish level.

<p>Visa Application Procedures (for non EU students)</p>	<p>You must apply for and obtain your visa at your home country, prior to coming to Spain. Please take contact directly with the Spanish Consulate.</p> <p>Applications may not be accepted more than 90 days before you are due to travel, or less than 45 days before your departure date. It may take 4 weeks or longer to process your application. Please, check this information with your local Spanish Consulate.</p> <p>The cost to apply for the visa depends on the Spanish Consulate of your country. We advise you to check with them the payment method. The fee is non-refundable.</p> <p>PLEASE BE AWARE that if you have a Student Visitor Visa you will not be able to work (either paid work or unpaid/voluntary work).</p> <p>A financial proof would be required for your visa application if you are not an EU citizen.</p> <p>If you need any document from our institution to get your VISA don't hesitate to contact us: incoming@ucv.es</p>
